District Update



Fentanyl Hearing

- ▶ On March 3, 2022 we hosted a **Fentanyl Hearing with Local Law Enforcement, Health Experts, and Policymakers.**
- ▶ **Our approach prioritizes treatment & holds drug traffickers accountable.**
- ▶ **Requesting** financial data from **local law enforcement** and other entities to **quantify the costs**, as we pursue funding.
- ▶ **Law Enforcement and Public Safety:** AB 1351 to stop fentanyl at its source and appropriately align fentanyl trafficking with cocaine and heroin in California's criminal code.

Treatment: Increasing healthcare treatment and distribution of Naloxone.

Education: Expanding early intervention, prevention, and education campaigns like "1 Pill Can Kill" across our County and School Districts.

Reducing Homelessness

- ▶ **Our 3-day 2022 Point in Time count resulted in a turnout of 600 volunteers.**
- ▶ The Point-in-Time Count is a biennial count and survey of people experiencing homelessness in Orange County.
- ▶ Provides vital information to help us better understand and respond to homelessness and allocate funding.
- ▶ **Fewer encampments and unhoused residents in Orange County than during our last countywide survey in 2019.**
- ▶ Helped secure \$3.6 million in funding to clean up the Talbert Park encampment in Costa Mesa, California.



COVID Update

- ▶ In March of 2021, less than 20% of our District's residents were vaccinated. Now, 75% of Orange County residents (5 and up) are fully vaccinated.
- ▶ This results in **2,437,965** fully vaccinated residents and **1,207,236 residents** with booster shots or additional doses. (3/8/22)
- ▶ As of **March 1**, masks are no longer required indoors. California will no longer require masks in schools **after March 11**.
- ▶ More than **11,000 COVID-19 test kits distributed in 2021 and almost 5,000 in the last 2 months. We continue to pass out free saliva test kits.**
- ▶ **Daily test positivity rate is 4%** and decreasing along with hospitalizations. (3/7/22)



4th Street Business Initiative

- ▶ Met with 4th Street Business to discuss concerns about their customers being ticketed during the street renovation project.
- ▶ Helping small businesses remains a top priority for our office.
- ▶ Orange County Businesses can apply for a \$2,500 grant through March 15, 2022.
- ▶ Small businesses owned by women, Veterans, minorities, and individuals without documentation or with limited English proficiency are encouraged to apply.
- ▶ **Requirements:**

Fewer than 5 full-time equivalent employees in 2019 and 202.

Began operations prior to December 31, 2019.

Currently active and operating or a clear reopening plan.

OCTA

- ▶ Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA) and Teamsters Local 952, the union that represents the coach operators, finalized a contract that provides a signing bonus of \$2,000 from one-time funding leftover from the Cares Act. Drivers are also now guaranteed 15-minute breaks.
- ▶ OCTA offering permanent free bus passes for youth ages 6 to 18 years old.
- ▶ OCTA is the first large transit agency in the region to offer ongoing free bus rides to youth.
